Within the past 30 years the Corning Glass Museum has added over \$120 million of new exhibition space and collections. The trip will consist of a guided tour and self-guided attractions, with optional workshops and lectures at extra cost. The Corning website, www.cmog.org, lists optional attractions. The Rockwell American Museum, in downtown Corning, is dedicated to the American art experience and has one of the country's best Western art exhibits.

Though the immediate future is unpredictable, new programs are being planned, such as: CPR training; social media/computer, cell phone usage; Armed Forces day celebration with showing of the 1942 *Memphis Belle* and its decorated crew; plans to show a movie about the coal-mine fire that ravaged the town of Centralia, PA.; and late in the year, a lecture on American Native artifacts and a visit to the Tabor museum with lunch, TBD.
