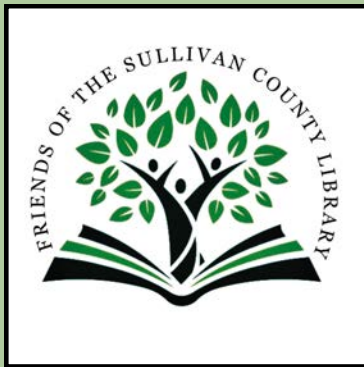

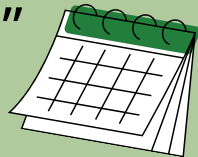

Friends Annual Meeting and "Best Friend" Celebration

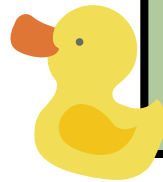

Time: 6:00 p.m.

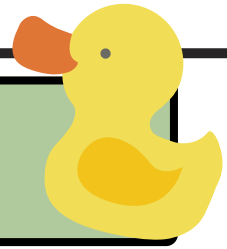
Location: Big Mike's Steaks and Hoagies, Forksville (next to the covered bridge)

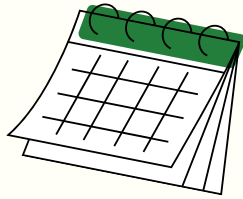
Regular meetings of the Friends Executive Board are scheduled for the first Tuesday of alternate months.
